1. Visit the Halifax River Audubon (HRA) booths and birdwatching stations. Watch for birds at these locations. Point them out to the HRA member. They will help you identify the bird. Write the bird in your field notes or check it on the list and collect a sticker from the official bird watcher.

2. Go on a bird walk with a guide in the park. Watch and listen and help the guide to find birds. Write the name of the bird in your field notes or check it on the list. At the end of the walk collect a sticker.

3. Do you have a bird question? Did you see something cool? Share with us. Stop by the Halifax River Audubon information tent or speak to one of our birdwatchers. Learn about the plants that birds need to survive. Learn about feathers and nests and more. You might just collect another sticker.

4. Participate in bird activities - Migration Challenge, Flyways Map, The Truth About Birds and collect a sticker.

When you have 10 bird names/check marks and 6 stickers, stop by the Halifax River Audubon information tent for a prize.
