What is that bird?

Everywhere you look in Florida you can observe birds. Sandpipers on the beach, herons along the river, mockingbirds in the yard. But have you ever noticed a bird that has taken you by surprise? Have you ever wondered what that bird is? If you have, then you are a bird watcher.

Halifax River Audubon is offering a lecture and field trip series this fall that will build on that natural curiosity. In six sessions you will learn about the birds around us and travel to nearby places to see them. You will learn about the tools and skills that will help you to master this pastime and meet some great people along the way.

Three "units" will be offered consisting of a Wednesday evening class followed by an outdoor field trip experience on another day, each to a different birding destination. The units will be unique and participants are encouraged to attend all of the sessions. However, if your schedule only permits you to attend one or two weeks, please consider joining us at the one week rate.

The sessions are spaced every three weeks to allow for changes in the birds we might see. As winter approaches, more birds arrive in Florida and the bird watching just gets better.

Classes will be held live, on-line via Zoom. If you are new to Zoom we can help you get online. [Check our 2020 meeting page at Halifaxriveras.org](#) . Scroll to the bottom to view what you will need to participate.

Classes and field trips are structured for adults who are new to bird watching or want to brush up their skills. Older children may participate if interested and accompanied by an adult. Your payment reserves a Zoom slot that can be enjoyed by all members of your household.

So dig out those binoculars and sign up. Class size is limited for the best experience possible, so apply early.
